For each term you must include:

1. The definition (what it means in your own words)
2. Three examples that display use of the term
 - *With the exception for the term Rhythm- this only needs one example*

Presentation of the Project: You may choose from the following:

- Create real-life posters/ signs / bookmarks for each term that includes the requirements (mentioned above) along with illustrations/pictures/decoration to make the posters visually appealing (Posters/ Signs/ Bookmarks must be typed or written in marker/pen and colored)
- Creating a PowerPoint, Google Presentation or Prezi that includes the 12 terms mentioned above along with their requirements. Pictures or video for each term that displays its use or meaning is also required for each term.
- Create your own website: You can link to the 12 different terms of figurative language, or present these terms in a way which meets the requirements mentioned above. **This is one of the best ways to show your creativity!** You can link videos, pictures, other web-sites... ect Your website should be visually appealing.
 - Weebly.com or wix.com are the sites I'm familiar with building and creating that I know are free
- Create your own **Awards** - create awards to present to historical figures, celebrities, classmates, athletes...ect that demonstrates use of the 12 terms. You will make 12 different awards, and you should include which literary term you are demonstrating somewhere on the award. You are open to make this digital or a paper-book that can be shared and displayed for future students. Final projects should be typed or written in marker/pen and also colored to be visually appealing
